Ulf Papenfuß is Professor for Public Management & Public Policy at the Zeppelin University Friedrichshafen since September 2016 (puma.zu.de). Previously, he was Juniorprofessor for Public Management at the University of Leipzig since 2013. From 2008 to 2013 he was research assistant at the Chair for Public Administration and the Chair for Business Administration at the Helmut-Schmidt-University in Hamburg. From 1999 to 2013 he was an officer in the military police of the German Federal Armed Forces. After training and service as Officer, he studied business administration and political/administrative sciences from 2002 to 2006 at the Helmut-Schmidt-Universität and afterwards served as officer in Cologne and Berlin.

His research focuses, among other areas, on sustainable public corporate governance, integrated digital governance in corporate group/network structures, self-regulation, governance innovations and sustainable change in digital transformation processes and outcome orientated control. Under his scientific direction numerous big conferences have been realized, at the moment, amongst others, he leads the annual "Future Salon Public Corporate Governance" at the Zeppelin University Friedrichshafen.
