Subject-Specific Study and Examination Regulations for the Two-Year M.A. Study Program

Politics, Administration & International Relations | PAIR at Zeppelin University

dated 02/19/2020

Based on § 70 Para. 6 in conjunction with § 34 Para. 1 Item 1 of the law regarding universities in Baden-Württemberg (State Higher Education Act – LHG) in the version valid on March 16, 2020, the Senate of Zeppelin University has decided upon the following regulations, last amended on 02/19/2020, governing teaching, studies and examinations in the master study program Politics, Administration & International Relations.

§ 1 Study program objective

The research-oriented PAIR master program prepares students for a career in academia and in the public, non-profit and commercial sectors.

§ 2 Program structure

The study program is divided into 4 compulsory modulees (30 ECTS, 1-2 semesters) and up to 11 elective modules (max. 66 ECTS, 2-4 semesters) in the major phase and master thesis including a thesis defense in the master phase (24 ECTS, 4 study semester).

§ 3 Options

- (1) Options within a compulsory module or modules in the elective section can be found in Appendix 2 of these regulations.
- (2) As a rule, all mandatory and elective modules within the Zeppelin University master study programs that are not included in the student's own program can be chosen as a multidisciplinary elective module (depending on availability), as well as offerings from StudentStudies and GlobalStudies.
- (3) A minor qualification in PAIR is offered to students in other master study programs.
- (4) Participation in the "Creativity & Performance" workshop (provided it is not attended as part of the CCM elective module) and the "Value-added Entrepreneurship" workshop is open to students as an extracurricular activity; it is not graded with ECTS, but it may on request be reported in the diploma supplement.
- (5) Elective modules totaling max. 12 ECTS can be replaced with an internship or multidisciplinary modules. Alternatively, elective modules totaling 18 ECTS can be replaced with the "Elinor Ostrom Project" module.

(6) A track may be reported on the transcript of records; for this purpose, elective modules from the relevant track totaling at least 24 ECTS must be completed in accordance with Appendix 2.

§ 4 Authorization of the Examination Committee

When minor changes are made to the SSER, the faculty may allow the Central Examination Committee to make the decision, if consideration by the Senate is not considered necessary. For this purpose, the Central Examination Committee is authorized to undertake changes to these regulations, in the event of which, they will notify the Senate. This does not apply to significant changes, particularly those which affect the very essence, content-related orientation or the basic structure of the study program. Consideration by the senate is absolutely essential in this case. The faculty is always entitled to consult the Senate directly regarding any proposed changes.

§ 5 Effective date

These regulations come into force on the day of their publication.
