The room was adequate size with lots of storage. There's a shelving unit, a wardrobe and a dresser, you won't run out of space. There is also a dining table in the room near the window which was nice because I could stare out into the garden while enjoying meals. In the room were bunk beds, both comfortable. This room is located on the first floor with a bathroom and kitchen. For showers and baths however, you must use the second floor bathroom. With the room being off the kitchen, it's convenient but also can be a bit noisy when other people are cooking. The WiFi was adequate. The location of the house was great. A short walk to downtown, about 10 minutes. The house is near many bus stops. The closest bus stop is about a 2 minute or less walk. The bus to the university was about 40 minutes overall because of transfer times but still not too bad. The house overall was always clean and friendly.

Costs: 100.-€ per week (including all utilities; including use of a bicycle).
