

Minimum course requirements	No requirements for exchange students. We recommend exchange students to take 4 courses per semester (24 ECTS).
Language Classes	Free German language courses for foreign students. German language placement test at the beginning of the semester in order to find the right course level; English, French, Spanish language courses available.
